

Our first stop of the day will be at **Fireside Orchard & Garden in Northfield**, where you can purchase apples and apple products, an assortment of jams, jellies, local cheeses, honey, maple syrup and other goodies. We will then head to the **Faribault Woolen Mill** for a tour. The 156-year old story of the historic mill nestled along the Cannon River is still being woven. The Faribault Woolen Mill endures as one of the last vertical woolen mills in America. *Participants will need to walk or stand for about forty minutes, with wheelchairs, walkers and canes welcome. After the tour, shop for a wide range of woven goods including soft wool blankets, vintage wool scarves, and other wool home, men's, and women's accessories. We will then head to the **Depot Restaurant** for lunch, which will include meatloaf, mashed potatoes, gravy, vegetables, dinner rolls, a beverage, and dessert. After lunch, spend some time exploring the downtown shops within walking distance. The last stop will be at **Aspelund Winery**, where we will take a tasting tour and have the opportunity to purchase wine and other products. The property is like a park with oak trees, flowers, and gardens and gorgeous views overlooking Wanamingo and the Zumbro River Valley.
